This week

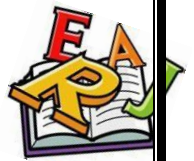
We wish you all Ramadan Kareem and all the best for this holy month. We also wish all the Amity fathers a Happy Father's Day for Sunday!

This week, in our topic lessons, we continued to learn about mermaids and discussed how to keep the environment in our waters clean.



In Maths this week, we have been learning about measurement. We discussed the different types of measurement; height, weight and capacity. The students learned how to use a height chart and were excited to see how tall they were! We used a variety of containers, experimenting with the capacity of each. We then measured out the liquids needed to make ice lollies! We also used scales to find the correct measurements to make salt dough!

We also focused on the Value of the Month, Love and Care. We spoke about the different ways of being caring and understood what the words 'care' and to 'look after' means, such as looking after our siblings and friends. We learnt how to care for our environment by recycling, reusing and reducing waste. Students discussed how they care for each other in their own families and made cards for their fathers in preparation for Father's Day on Sunday.

We have looked at a variety of different instruments, some for the first time including maracas, claves, triangles, bongos, djembe, xylophones, metallophones, rain-sticks and egg shakers. We have been guided on how to play them and then spent time in learning how to use them. We reacted to visual stimulus that told us to play either soft or loud, and fast or slow. It was so noisy and so much fun!

They also learnt 2 seasons (winter) (al-shetaa) (summer) (al-saaef).

The children have really enjoyed participating in these games and have shown excellent recall for previously learnt skills.
