This week

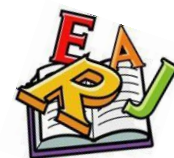
It has been a busy week in Grade 1. The children worked so hard completing their assessments and have shown us that they have remembered many things and extended their learning this year. Well done!
