
This week

The Nursery children have started a new activity block which is focused around team games. This week they continued to work in two teams to pass balls into a 'goal' area. They were encouraged to think about where the space was and how to attract the attention of the person they wished to 'pass' to. The children are currently rolling the balls to each other rather than throwing and they have different positional roles within their team.



Swimming



This week the children have continued to develop their confidence and stroke technique on both their fronts and their backs. The majority of students are now able to blow bubbles in the water and keep their head in the correct position when swimming independently and this has been greatly helped by the quality of goggles they are wearing; many thanks to you for providing these for your son / daughter.

As the end of the year fast approaches it is important that your child continues to participate in the swimming lessons and I appreciate your support in remembering their kit on the correct day and ensuring that if they are in school, they are an active participant.

Swimming is a compulsory part of the British National Curriculum and students are only exempt from taking part if they are injured or they have a Doctor's note. Our pool is maintained at a constant temperature and hot showers are provided afterwards for all students; medical advice is that swimming in our pool will in no way cause or exacerbate coughs.

Please be aware that for health and safety purposes, **ALL students are required to wear a swimming hat for their lessons.** Thank you for your co-operation and ongoing support with this and in ensuring that your child is becoming independent at getting changed.
