This week

We have continued this week with our new topic 'Turrets and Tiaras'. The children used their own coats of arms designs from last week to make a bigger crest that we painted. We also learned how to make different colours in art by mixing the primary colours. In computing we continued to learn how to type. This is a but tricky for some of us!



In Maths, we have been partitioning two and three digit numbers and used this to help us add and subtract numbers.

In English, we boxed-up the story of Cinderella and then used key words to write the beginning and end of the story.



In Science, we continued to learn about seasons. We learned what different changes occur in the weather and in trees when the seasons change from winter to spring.
