In English

Grade 4

This week we wrote some sci-fi stories for our school book that we will make after Book Week. We revised some of the terminology we needed and then made a plan for writing. Then after drafting, editing and proofing we typed up our stories. Next week we will be debating!

Grade 5

We have been finishing the paragraphs for our group Greek myths this week. The children have made individual story books, including the blurb and illustrations and have included at least one pop-up in their creations. We have also enjoyed the library scavenger hunt and listening to our mystery readers.

In Maths
Grade 4

This week the children have been continuing their work on fractions; refreshing their knowledge of adding and subtracting fractions with the same denominator and moving on to multiply proper fractions and mixed numbers by whole numbers. We continue to refresh and improve on our mental maths and times tables.



Grade 5

We have been learning about angles in triangles, quadrilaterals and pentagons this week and have practiced drawing 2D shapes with given angles. We have also been comparing and classifying geometric shapes based on their properties and sizes.

In Science



Grade 4

This week Grade 4 have been looking at separating mixtures; what are methods of separating mixtures/materials and focussing on the processes of filtration and dissolving through an experiment.

Grade 5

We have continued our work on Animals including Humans this week. The children have designed a poster to encourage a healthy lifestyle and are beginning to think about the effects of exercise on the human body.

Music



Grade 4

We sang our Aztec song in the auditorium this week so that we could practise using louder voices to project the song to the audience. We are ready to have an audience now 😊

Grade 5

In music we practised the songs for our production 'Alice' and used glockenspiels to play music alongside. We thought about rhythms to play and when to allow singers to sing without accompaniment.

Computing



Grade 4

This week we have managed to have multiple turns using the laptops in class. We have used this time to explore Education City. We have had a blast challenging each other in Maths, even challenging our teachers!

Grade 5

This week we learnt how to copy 3D elements from our SketchUp models and paste them into other areas where the same object or detail is needed. We completed our rooves and next week we hope to print them to display in class.

Spanish



Grade 4

This week, we have started a two part lesson which aims at helping children to understand a role play, come up with their own role play and act it. In terms of phonetics children learnt to pronounce 'll' correctly.

Children will have to evaluate their own and others' performances and share what they thought was good and one area for improvement.

Grade 5

Our aim this week, was to understand transactional language in a shop/icecream stall situation, as well as understand a few verbs in formal and informal forms, pronounce 'rr' correctly and finally write a role play dialogue from memory with reasonable spelling (this last point was set as a homework task, children have been given a week to complete).
