



This week


In Maths we have completed our fraction topic by solving a range of fraction word problems. The children used their reasoning and problem solving skills to identify whether they needed to find a fraction of an amount, equivalent fractions or add or subtract fractions- fantastic!

In English, the children have defined the different types of plays. The children discussed the play genres and the features and characters that would be found in each. In particular, the boys enjoyed studying the 'horror' genre and the girls enjoyed 'the love story'!



In science, we investigated how a shadow changes throughout the day. We began by choosing a spot to stand in in the morning and sketched our shadows. The children predicted what their shadow would look like at lunchtime. We then stood in the same spot at lunchtime and in the afternoon and discussed how our shadows had changed length and position!
