This week


This week the children have further developed their written methods for division. They have learnt how to use the 'bus stop method' or short division to divide 2 digit numbers by 1 and 2 digit numbers as well as divide and find the remainder. To put the learning into context, we have also solved a range of real life multiplication and division problems.

In English, we have focused on the images used in 'Voices in the Park'. The children have used powerful vocabulary and similes to describe various mysterious scenes from the story and gained inspiration from the book to create and describe their own imaginary and enchanting setting!



This week, we have learned about the three functions of the skeleton: to protect, support and help the body to move. The children discussed what would happen if we didn't have a skeleton and we agreed that we'd fall to the ground- like jelly! We also discussed the types of joints and how they help us to move.
