

This week


This week in English we looked at 'Q' word spellings and definitions. We discussed new vocabulary and identified times when we could use new words in sentences. We worked together in groups to create our Non- Chronological Reports and also created similar reports using laptops.

This week's focus in Maths for some children has been Time (Measures) where they worked practically using Analogue clocks on O' Clock, Half Past, Quarter to and Quarter Past. The children completed some interactive Time challenges which they really enjoyed. With Miss Emma the children have continued to convert different measurements and then used their knowledge to solve word problems. Later in the week they rounded numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and whole number.



This week we looked at series and parallel Electrical Circuits. We also learned about electric symbols and components. We will continue to work on this topic and further discuss terms such as conductor, insulator, power, supply etc. The children discussed inventors and together we researched inventors that have impacted on our lives today. We looked at a range of electronic household items as well as what people used before they were invented.
