



This week


In Maths, we continued to learn about multiplication and how sums can be written in two ways but still have the same answer (i.e $2 \times 3 = 6$, $3 \times 2 = 6$). We also began learning about division and how it is the inverse of multiplication. We divided numbers by grouping and sharing them equally.

In English, we wrote our own set of instructions on how to make a sandwich. We choose our own filling and bread. We also began to look at instructions for playing a board game. We designed our own board games and used imperative verbs (bossy verbs) to instruct our class mate of how to play.



In science we used the data that we collected last week to help us create bar graphs and pictographs of our classes' favourite weather. We then answered questions based on the graphs such as what was the most popular weather, what was the least popular weather, etc.

We have finished all the sections of our Olympic song, now we just have to keep practicing it to make sure it sounds as good as can be! We revised our favourite songs and rhythms from throughout the year and tried to combine different skills that we have learned through a variety of different activities. We have looked at a variety of different instruments, some for the first time. We have been guided on how to play them and then spent time in learning how to use them in small groups.
