



# **Uniform Policy**

**Final Version**

## **Uniform and P.E. Kit**

With the exception of official non-uniform days all pupils are required to wear school uniform every school day and this uniform must conform to the shades, styles, textures and colours determined by the school and in keeping with the uniform stocked by the school suppliers. Uniform should be clean and tidy at all times and it should be worn in full to and from school, as well as in public.

During the warmer months students will need to wear hats for outdoor play. All children should wear flat soled non-marking black shoes which should be properly polished. Class Teachers are expected to play their part in enforcing this dress code.

The full uniform list is available on the website and is provided here as an attachment. The list shows the variations for each part of the school and gives details of the official school supplier who is housed on the school site, in the main reception area.

The PE uniform is worn for PE and Sports Club lessons.

In addition to uniform PE bag, Book Bag and Rucksack are also required and are available at the school shop. Trolley bags are not permitted.

No jewellery is permitted and this includes friendship bands. Girls may wear discrete stud earrings but these must be removed or taped over for PE and Games. Girls' hair may be long or short but if long, i.e. below the chin, it must be tied back. Boys' hair should be cut to a conventional short style i.e. off the collar, above the ears and with a short fringe. It should not be combed with any colouring or gel.

It is particularly important that all uniform items are named so that lost property can be reunited with its owner quickly. Any lost property which is found should be placed in the lost property areas. Lost property whose owner can be identified is returned to its owner on a regular basis.

The school reserves the right to refuse entry to pupils who persistently (i.e. after reasonable warning) refuse to follow the school uniform and dress codes.

If required, a school sweater can be worn during the winter months. This is available at the school shop.

Socks should be ankle length, white for girls and black for boys. Shoes must be black. Sports shoes are not permitted as part of the school uniform.

For swimming, boys should wear swim shorts and girls a tankini. This will allow children to come to school wearing their swimming kit on the appropriate days. A swimming cap will also be required and can be purchased at the school shop.

If required, a school sweater can be worn during the winter months and will be available at the school shop.
