

## 1. Policy Statement

---

Amity International School (The 'School') requires all students to wear a school uniform every school day, unless it a special theme day or home clothes day. The uniform must conform to the shades, styles, textures and colours determined by the school, and in keeping with the uniform stocked by the school suppliers.

## 2. Aims

---

The aims and purpose of this policy is to:

- Reflect school community standards and expectations.
- Contribute to the health and safety of students when engaged in school activities.

## 3. Practice and Procedure

---

### 3.1 General Rules for all pupils

---

- The uniform should be clean and tidy at all times and it should be worn in full, to and from school, as well as in public.
- Jewellery is not permitted. This includes friendship bands. Girls may wear one pair of plain small earrings, as long as they are able to remove them independently during PE classes for safety reasons.
- The PE uniform is worn for PE and Sports lessons.
- Hair must be neat in style and natural in colour. It must be clean, tidy and brushed. Extravagant or ostentatious hairstyles are not permitted.
- Girls may wear a navy, black or brown hair band. No other coloured hair accessories or ties are permitted.
- Boys' hair should be cut to a conventional short style, i.e. off the collar, above the ears.
- During the warmer months, students are required to wear hats for outdoor play. Primary, Reception, and Nursery children should wear an Amity hat.

### 3.2 Naming items

---

- It is important that all uniform items are named so that lost property can be reunited with its owner. Any lost property that is found is placed in the lost property. Any lost property, whose owner can be identified, is returned to its owner on a regular basis. Unreturned lost and found items are displayed termly and parents/students invited to collect their own lost property. Any unclaimed items are disposed of at the end of each term.

### 3.3 Purchasing and Ordering

---

- Uniform items can be ordered and purchased either from the school uniform shop, which is located on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor near the auditorium, or online from the supplier's website: <https://shopatsumeru.com/> you can also email them at [info@shopatsumeru.com](mailto:info@shopatsumeru.com). The uniform shop in school is open from Saturday to Thursday 7.30am - 4.00pm (timings may change during school holiday periods). Cash or card are accepted.
- One set of uniform costs approximately AED600 for Foundation Stage, Primary, and Secondary.
- The full uniform list is published on the school's website.

### 3.4 Sanctions

---

- If students repeatedly fall foul of school uniform regulations, the school will follow the procedures as detailed in the school's behaviour policy. The school reserves the right to refuse entry to pupils who persistently (i.e. after reasonable warning) fail to follow the school uniform and dress codes.
- Final decisions on what constitutes the proper uniform are at the discretion of the Head of School.

### 3.5 Nursery and Reception Uniform List

---

- In addition to the uniform, a PE bag and a book bag are also required and are available at the school shop.
- No jewellery or make-up of any form is permitted.

### 3.6 Primary Uniform List (Years 1 to 6)

- In addition to the uniform, a PE bag, book bag and backpack are also required and are available at the school shop. Bags with wheels are not permitted.
- No jewellery or make-up of any form is permitted.
- Mobile phones, Apple watches, electronic games, iPods, MP3 players or similar are not allowed in the Primary school, unless required for medical reasons (in this case a request must be made to the Head of School).

### 3.7 Secondary Uniform List (Years 7 to 11)

- Boys should have a clean shaven appearance unless permitted by the Head of Secondary for reasons of cultural sensitivity.

### 3.8 Sixth Form Uniform List (Year 12 and 13)

In the Sixth Form, fitting with their status as young adults, students are encouraged to dress smartly in formal business attire as defined below.

- Make-up should be kept to bare minimum (foundation, mascara and colourless nail varnish only.)  
 Coloured nail varnish is not permitted, unless specifically allowed by the school for that event.  
 False nails are not permitted.

- Boys should have a clean shaven appearance unless permitted by the Head of Secondary for reasons of cultural sensitivity
- A sixth form Amity photo ID badge must be worn.

### 3.9 School Bags

Heavy School Bags are a serious threat to the health and wellbeing of the students. It has a severe, adverse physical effect on the growing children and anxiety.

Parents are requested to ensure that school bags do not weigh more than 20% of the body weight of the child. The table below has the recommended weight limits by year group as advised by the Abu Dhabi schools' regulator.
